## Dear friends,

It is our great pleasure to invite you to participate in a series of online sessions on the topic of "Shrinking Civic Spaces" that will be held between the 27th of May and the 17th of June.

Amidst the continuous spread of the coronavirus and COVID-19 around the globe, we had to postpone and suspend all our events. However, in order to keep our work going, we have worked to transfer our main theme this year 'Shrinking Civic Spaces' online!

The overall aim of the sessions is to look at the recent rollbacks in the public provision of civic spaces globally and to identify how young people can counter such tendencies. We will look at the specific roles of young politicians and civil society activists in the defence of civic spaces and how the capacity of young people can be bolstered to actively partake in the defence and expansion of civic spaces on the ground.

The series will consist of several online sessions. The duration of the sessions is between 60 and 90 minutes per session and might include some preparatory work in between the sessions, such as readings or assignments.
